There will be a charge of \$30 for checks returned with insufficient funds. If you would like to run a tab during the show for additional class fees or shavings, you may submit an "OPEN" and signed check with your entry form.

Show Office Hours: Friday, May 23, 8:00 a.m. – until 1 hour after classes, Sat., May 24th and Sun., May 25th, 7:30 am until 1 hour after last class.

Refunds: Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit office and stall fees. No substitution of horses will be permitted. Entry fee refunds will be made only with the presentation of vet certificate which must be on file with the show secretary by the end of the show.

Prize Money and Ribbons: For Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes, monies will be mailed within 30 days of the show.

Prize money in all Performance and Championship classes will be \$50.00 per class and to be split as follows: 1st= \$20, 2nd= \$15,

3rd=\$10 & 4th=\$5. No payback will be issued in classes with less than 5 horses. No payback in Breeding/Halter, Equitation, Showmanship, Horsemanship or AHA Medal classes. All monies will be in the form of a check made out to owner of horse. Ribbons to 6th place in all classes and Championship classes will be placed with Championship and Reserve ribbons. Lead line class exhibitors will all receive similar ribbons.

MAHA Championship Classes: Championship classes must be entered before the end of the last break scheduled before the Championship classes begin. You must have shown in at least one of the qualifying classes listed for that Championship Class.

AHA Medal Classes: Open to junior riders only. For an AHA medal to be awarded, three (3) competitors with proper appointments must compete. Points will be earned in Medal classes w/fewer than 3 riders. See next page for Medal Class specifications.

TBA Class Slots: TBA slots to be filled on a first come, first serve basis through a class sponsorship of \$25/per class. There are only a limited number of TBA slots available. Once filled, there will be no more TBA classes available and there will be no added classes.

To buy and sponsor a TBA class, please indicate which class you would like and where you would like to have the class placed in the schedule. Any TBA classes purchased will not count for sweepstakes.

MSHSA Classes: Ribbons to 6th place in all MSHSA classes. Paybacks offered only for MSHSA classes marked with an asterisk (*).

Payback is based on percentage of number of horses entered in those payback classes and checks will be mailed within 30 days. All MSHSA shows are judged according to MSHSA rules unless otherwise specified. MSHSA rules and patterns may be viewed at www.mshsa.org.

RV Electrical Hook-up: Hook ups will be provided for \$25/night. If you are planning on staying at one of RV sites, please include this fee on your entry form.

Dogs: Metra Park regulations and safety require that all dogs and pets be leashed or confined at all times.

Stalling: Permanent wood box stalls with double doors are located in the race barn area near the Super Barn. Stalls come with 1 bag of shavings. Show stall fees of \$60 are for horses arriving on 5/22 & leaving on the morning of 5/26 ONLY. Early arrival and late departure fees are \$15/day. Extra shavings will be available during the show for an additional charge. A grounds fee of \$25 per day will be charged for horses not in stalls

Arena: Show arena is 90x180. Footing is a mixture of sand and sawdust. Warm up arena adjacent to show arena has dirt, sand and sawdust.

Concessions: Food or concessions will be available.

Post Entries: There will be a one time post entry fee of \$25 per horse for all entries post marked after 5/16/08

USEF: Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Judge's Information: Patrick Newby has been judging Arabian Horses for 25 years and has shown his Arabians to numerous Regional and National honors in all divisions.

ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION MEDAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

AHA Saddle Seat Medal class

- (1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used.

AHA Reining Seat Medal class

- (1) All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06.)
- (2) Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- (3) Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- (4) In an AHA reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
- (5) The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5. (Res. 25-06)
- (6) Numbers must be worn on the rider's back or in the case of reining seat equitation on the left side of the saddle pad and must be clearly visible at all times when in competition. See USEF rule EQ103.6. (Res. 8/07)

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class

- (1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

All exhibitors entered in the Arabian or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes must be a current AHA member with a Competition Card or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$10.00 per person. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/ discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$10 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT – Regional and Local Show

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and Directory and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equine Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.
